

RIVER EVENLODE BRIDGE (ASCOTT-UNDER-WYCHWOOD): PROPOSED TRAFFIC PRIORITY CALMING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to implement the following traffic calming feature under the Highways Act 1980 sections 90G-90I for road safety reasons:

On the bridge crossing the <u>River Evenlode</u>, approx. 215 metres north-west of the northern entrance to Ascott-under-Wychwood village;

- A signed & lined (i.e. no physical constructions) priority working for traffic crossing the bridge;
 - with priority given to traffic travelling north-westwards out of the village.
 - Vehicles travelling south-east towards the village will be required to give way to oncoming traffic.
